

TICC Update
January 2013

Below is a listing of Transparency Initiative Coordinating Committee activities for the month:

1. TICC Chair provided an oral progress report to AAPOR's Executive Council on January 10.
2. The full TICC held a conference call on January 15, during which progress and future activities were reviewed. Several members volunteered to prepare generic examples of documents we plan to post on the TI web site as reference materials for Transparency Initiative applicants to adopt as needed.
3. All five informational modules have now been prepared and recorded. The first four have been posted on the Transparency Initiative's web page (http://www.aapor.org/TI_Informational_Modules.htm), and the fifth will be posted shortly. These materials have been designed for use as part of the upcoming pilot test, and will hopefully serve as models for final materials that will be used once the full Transparency Initiative is opened for business. Below is a listing of the titles of the five modules:
 - a. Promoting transparency in survey research
 - b. How does my organization join the Transparency Initiative?
 - c. Citizenship in the Transparency Initiative
 - d. The Transparency Initiative's immediate disclosure elements
 - e. Additional Transparency Initiative disclosure elements
