



**TICC Monthly Report
September 19, 2013**

We view the Transparency Initiative as a collection of professional organizations who have pledged to adhere to the AAPOR Code of disclosure of methodological details for all surveys they publicly report. Our emphasis will be on support, education and encouragement of good faith efforts to be as transparent as possible. The goal will be to minimize the burden of and disincentives to participation. We are continuing with the second pilot test that was begun in August. To date, we have received feedback from seven participants and are in the process of revising and updating our materials and processes in response to that feedback. We will then continue the pilot by eliciting feedback from additional organizations and continue with this iterative process until no additional concerns are raised by new pilot participants.
