The TICC met on February 19 to review progress to date. It was reported that TICC Chair Tim Johnson is now meeting on a weekly basis with AAPOR staff Lisa Kamen and Abra Alscher to coordinate ongoing activities as we move towards implementation. On February 20, Johnson represented TICC during the AAPOR Council's monthly meeting in order to discuss whether or not fees would be charged to Transparency Initiative applicants during the first year of the initiative. It was decided that decisions regarding the charging of fees would be made during the March 2014 Council meeting. On February 26, a demonstration was arranged by AAPOR staff to examine a potential software package that might be used to manage the TI application and review process. Also during February, the scripts for the five TI educational modules were revised, based on feedback collected during the second pilot test. The TI policies and procedures document was also revised based on the pilot test feedback.
