

Transparency Initiative Coordinating Committee (TICC)

The TICC held a monthly conference call on June 3. Several topics were discussed, including committee membership transitions, plans for future meetings during which we will discuss organizational concerns regarding Transparency Initiative membership from representatives of various sectors, ongoing revisions of TI materials in light of the revisions to AAPOR's Code, which were approved in May, and discussions, led by Dave Lambert, regarding data disclosure requirements. Later in the month, we were informed that Jamie Dayton from ICF International (a member of the Transparency Initiative) had been approved by AAPOR's Executive Council as the newest member of the TICC. No new members were admitted to the Transparency Initiative this month, but we have spent considerable time reviewing and working with seven organizations that currently have applications pending for admission into the Transparency Initiative. Also, we neglected to report that late last month, on May 28<sup>th</sup>, TICC Chair Tim Johnson traveled to AAPOR's offices in Deerfield, Illinois to meet with AAPOR Executive Director Susan Tibbitts, and new AAPOR staff members Crystal Stone, who has assumed responsibility for providing staff support to the Transparency Initiative, and Jill Hronek, new Director of Communication & Marketing, to review TI progress and future plans.
