TICC minutes

1. Tim Triplett provided an updated on the biennial evaluations
  - a. 58 organizations have successfully completed their biennial evaluation
  - b. 1 organization have been removed from the TI
  - c. 2 organizations have been (voluntarily) suspended for 12 months
2. Ashley and Tim provided an update on IPSOS who are now compliant with the TI and Intramedia who the TICC is working with to move off of suspension
3. The TICC discussed expanding membership to surveying sampling members. This will need to be approved by AAPOR Executive Council. Ashley and Tim have prepared the following draft to submit to council next week:

As you know, currently the AAPOR Transparency Initiative is open to “survey organizations, including survey subunits of larger organizations (henceforth, organizations), that produce surveys and/or commission, sponsor or report them publicly.” The TICC is interested in expanding membership to organizations with the primary responsibility of providing samples to survey organizations. The TICC understands that this would require developing a new set of disclosure elements for these organizations. We are asking the AAPOR Executive Council if the TICC could put together subcommittee of individuals in order to begin examining the possibility of expanding organization membership in the TI.

4. Ashley reported that there are no new applications.
5. TICC committee members were informed of three interested individuals who would like to join the TICC in May. Ashley and Tim will be running these individuals by AAPOR Executive Council.
